In contrast is Switzerland, my native country, where I live and work. The fact that my actual employer is investing in India led to the idea to identify the main elements of our management relations on a cultural basis. The research ascertains that Swiss (or European) companies should reflect on their mindsets before pursuing business relations with Indians to determine whether they are well-prepared to do business with Indian business partners.
