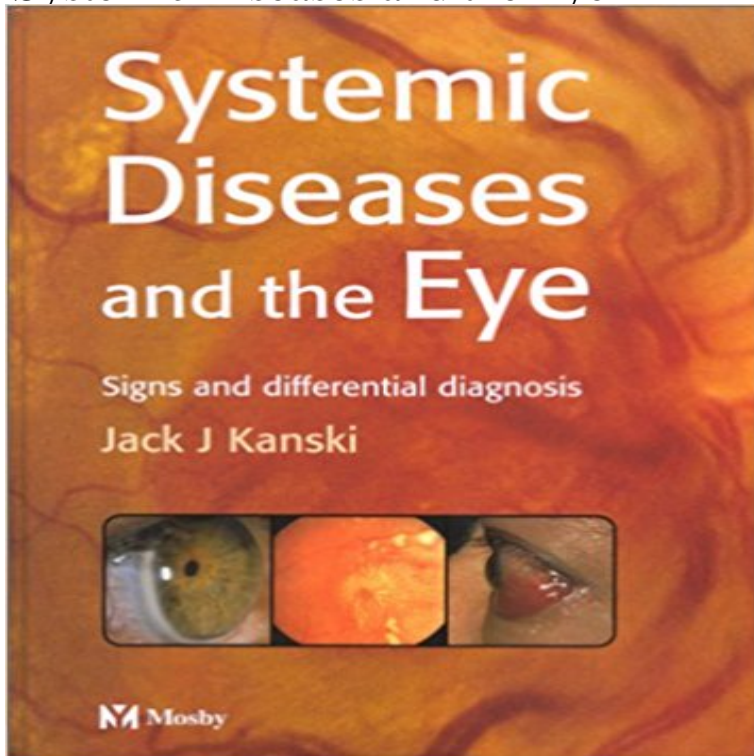


Systemic Diseases and the Eye
