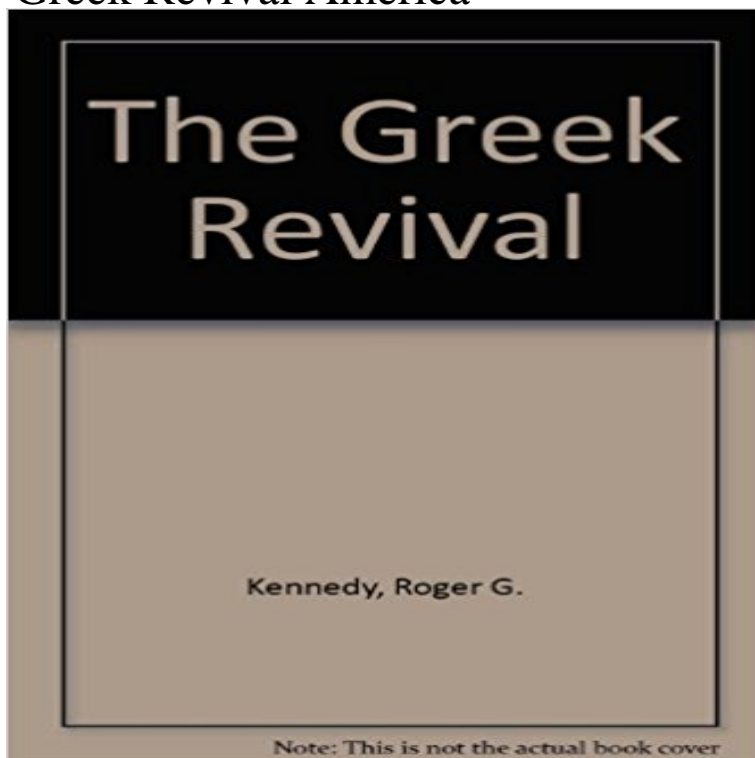


Greek Revival America
