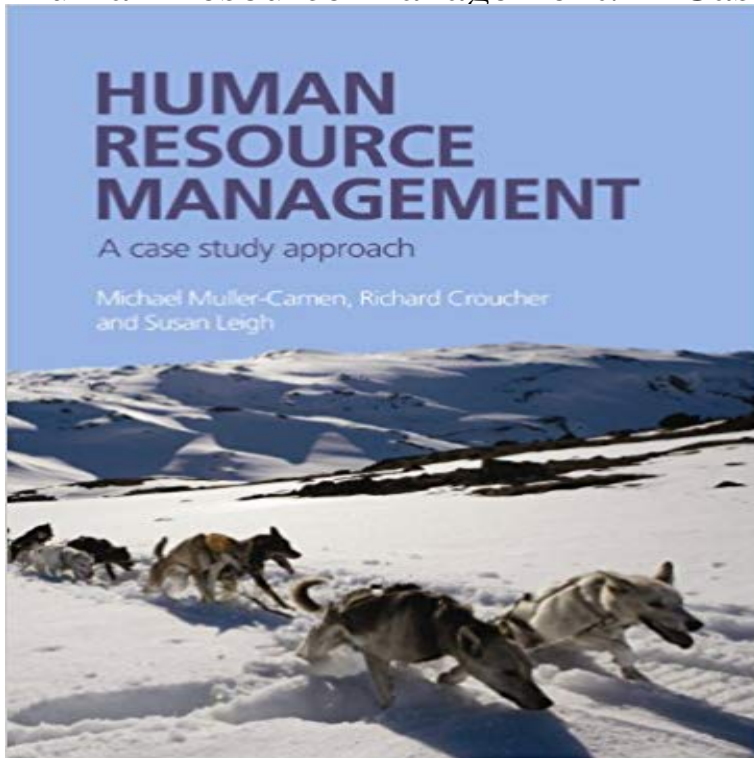


Human Resource Management: A Case Study Approach
