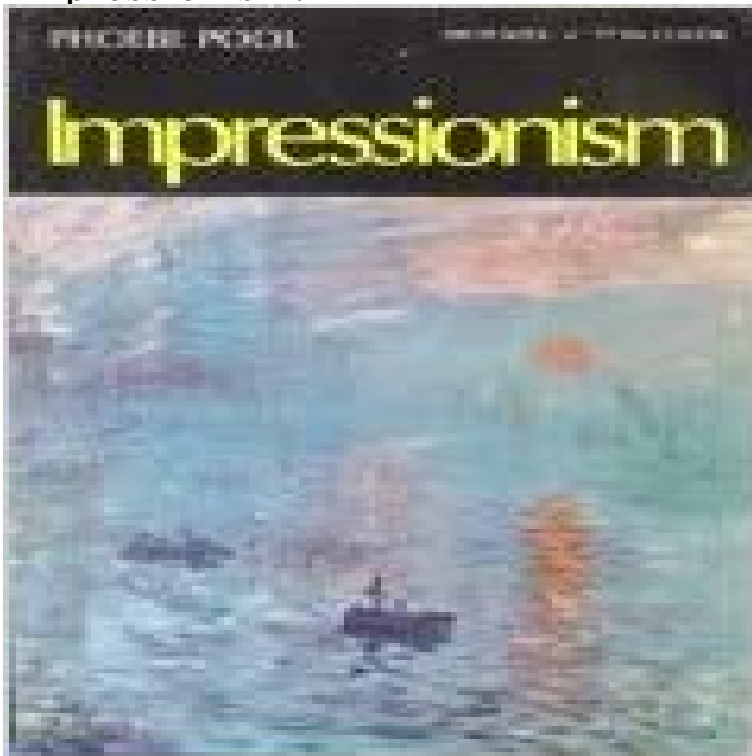


## Impressionism.
