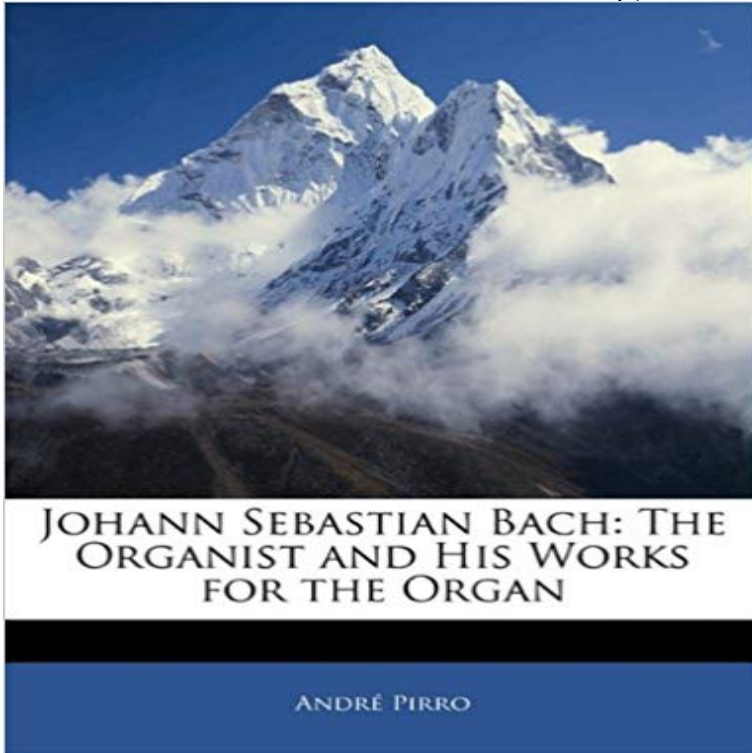


## Johann Sebastian Bach: The Organist and His Works for the Organ
