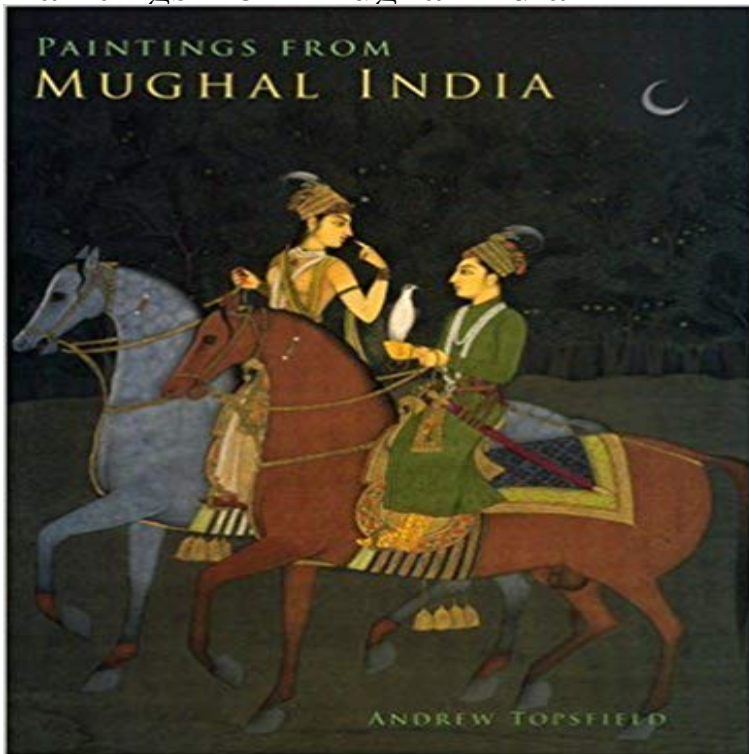


Paintings from Mughal India
