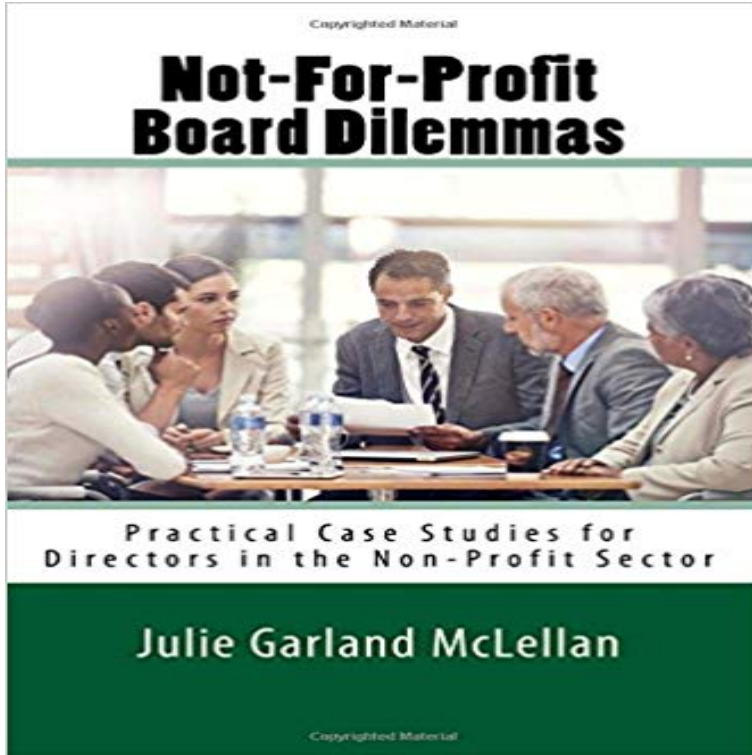


Not-For-Profit Board Dilemmas: Practical Case Studies for Directors in the Non-Profit Sector
