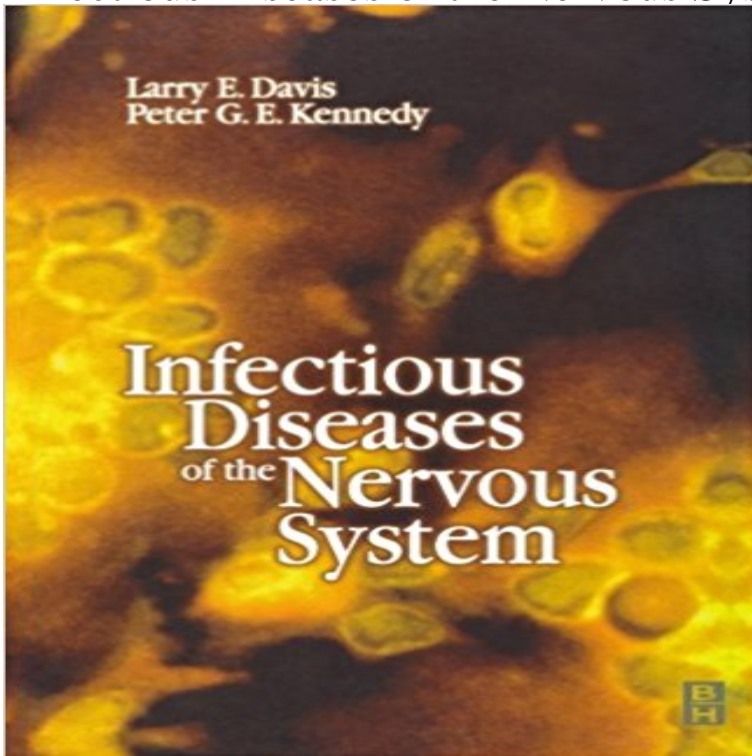


Infectious Diseases of the Nervous System, 1e
