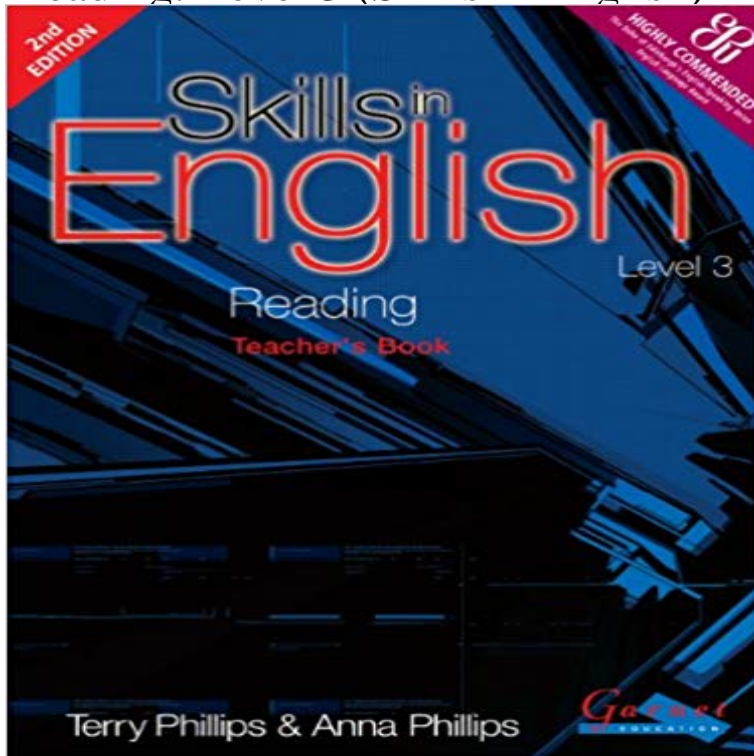


## Reading: Level 3 (Skills in English)

- \* confirm precise meaning;
- \* find the main point of an article;
- \* understand negative prefixes;
- \* recognise supposition;
- \* find the main information in: an active sentence, a passive sentence, a complex sentence with participles; a complex sentence with embedded that / which / who clauses;
- \* look for evidence in a text;
- \* understand internal definitions;
- \* do research on the Internet using search engines and indexes / FAQs;
- \* use hyperlinks;
- \* understand the writers attitudes;
- \* make inferences about background knowledge;
- \* and understand tables and figures.

In addition, students acquire key vocabulary in the following thematic areas:
