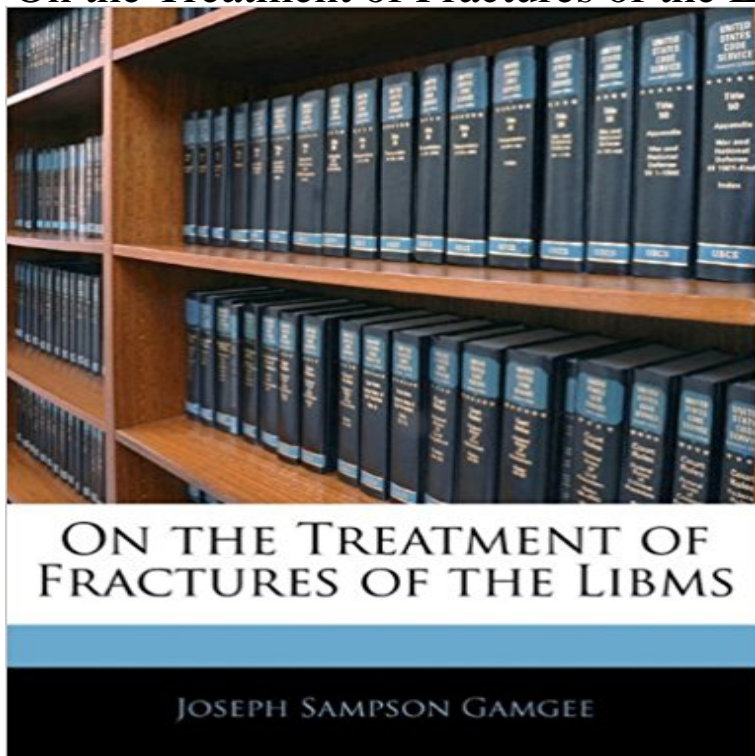


On the Treatment of Fractures of the Limbs
